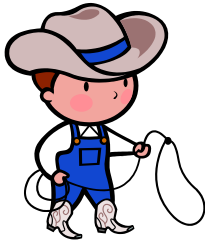


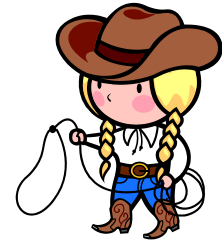

Little Miss Cowgirl/ Little Mr. Cowboy Pageant Union County Fair & Livestock Show Contest Information and Rules

The Union County Fair & Livestock show is hosting a western wear pageant for boys and girls ages 1 to 12 years old. Contestants are not required to live in Union County and the contest is open to all children of the appropriate age.

Each contestant should dress in “cowboy and cowgirl” style clothing including boots, cowboy hats, and assorted western attire. They may choose to wear jeans, shirts, skirts, dresses, chaps or vests. They may also choose assorted western accessories such as lariats, spurs, etc. **No weapons of any kind may be worn or used as an accessory and no live animals will be allowed.**

Each contestant must submit the required forms and pay a \$5.00 non-refundable entry fee. Payments accepted will be cash or check.

Age categories for judging:

- 1 to 2 - Lil Ms. & Mr. Trail Blazer
- 3 to 4 - Lil Ms. & Mr. Buckaroo
- 5 to 7 – Lil Ms. & Mr. Caballero
- 8 to 10 – Jr. Little Ms. Cowgirl & Jr. Little Mr. Cowboy
- 11 to 12 – Little Ms. Cowgirl & Little Mr. Cowboy



Judging will be based on four areas: Overall Attire, Personality, Self Confidence-Poise, and Grooming. The purpose of the contest is to encourage and boost confidence in youth. Judges decisions are final.

Awards: Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each age categories. All contestants will receive a participation ribbon.

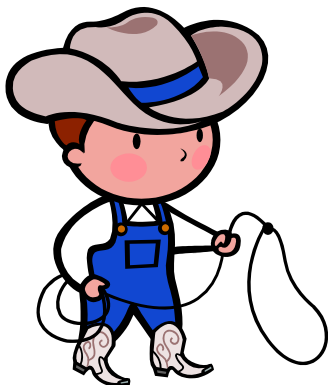
